## **In-Class Workshop for Policy Briefs**

Data Visualization Using R Spring 2025

This workshop has multiple goals

- 1. To prod you into doing some of your work early enough that you'll have time to reflect on what you've done and make helpful changes.
- 2. In the processing of explaining your work to your classmates, realize things that are unclear or confusing.
- 3. Get useful feedback from your classmates.
- 4. Develop your skills in both in critiquing graphics, and in improving them by giving helpful suggestions to your classmates.

With these goals in mind, your charge for class April 7 is to

- post **24 hours in advance** (so by April 6, 3 pm)
- rough drafts of 4 graphs (recalling that the final brief should have 5 to 8+ charts)
- a storyline for your policy brief
- more is better!
- post to this the google folder to which I have linked on Blackboard
  - o post your graphics and and text into your assigned group (see below) in the "drafts" subfolder
  - o perhaps make a subfolder for each group member

I've assigned you into groups of 3 or 4 students and you'll walk the other students through the brief and solicit feedback. If you are in a group, it was my intention to split you up. Let me know ASAP by email if this list does not reflect this.

After class, you have two (short) assignments:

- 1. Write comments for each of the classmates/groups to which you are assigned
  - These are due Thursday April 10 at 5 pm
  - Post to your group's google folder, subfolder "comments"
  - Use the naming convention [policy brief author name]\_comments\_from\_[comments author name].docx/pdf
- 2. Write a short memo summarizing how you will modify your brief based on this workshop
  - This is due **Monday April 14** by the start of class
  - Each group should write one memo
  - Post to your group's google subfolder, subfolder "response to comments"
  - Use the naming convention [policy brief author]\_comments\_summary
